IN PREVENTING THE SPREAD AND INFECTION OF THE CORONA VIRUS**



Within Gifu Prefecture, we are already in the "Second Wave State of Emergency" and the number of COVID-19 infections continues to rise. As the number of infections spread, may we request everyone to spend this summer with care and precaution. Continue to be vigilant and do not to let your guard down in preventing the spread of the Corona Virus.

With this, may we remind everyone to:

1. Always wear mask when in public, maintain proper distance with each other all the time, practice regular hand washing and don't forget to disinfect.
2. Avoid or be cautious in going on trips/traveling between prefectures.
3. Avoid places with high risk of infection (large gatherings, parties, barbecues and karaoke etc.)
4. Avoid the 3C's, particularly eating & drinking or partying with alcohol. Avoid joining unnecessary group gatherings and drinking sessions in areas with high rates of infection such as Nagoya and other close by areas.
